The Written Word and the Spirit of God

II Pet 1:21 Prophecy: foretelling or forthtelling by revelation

Gal 1:11-12 By revelation

Num 11:17 Spirit upon

Deut 34:9 Full of the spirit

Introduction to the Manifestations of Holy Spirit

I Cor. 12:7-10

vs. 7 But - sets in contrast
To profit withal: for profit

vss. 8-10 To one...to another: for one (profit)...for another (profit)
By their very nature, the nine manifestations of holy spirit fall in three groups:

I. Utterance Manifestations:

1. Speaking in tongues
2. Interpretation of tongues
3. Prophecy

II. Revelation Manifestations:

1. Word of knowledge
2. Word of wisdom
3. Discerning of spirits

III. Impartation Manifestations:

1. Faith (believing)
2. Workings of miracles
3. Gifts of healings

vs. 11 Worketh: are energized - "The one and the selfsame spirit energizes all these..."
Severally: *idios* - his own (as he, the man, wills)
(Acts 3:6, 7 - such as I have give I thee)

Session 2

Summary of Utterance Manifestations/Comparison to Revelation

Six Manifestations Available Prior to Pentecost – Revelation and Impartation

II Peter 1: 20,21 – prophecy = revelation

Other examples: Luke 1: 40-55 – Mary & Elisabeth; I Samuel 10: 5-13 – Saul

Three New Manifestations Since Pentecost – S.I.T., Interpretation and Prophecy

Explained in the Book of Acts and the Church Epistles, notably I Corinthians 12-14.

The other six are explained in the Old Testament and the Gospels.

“To the Church” – when did the Church come into existence? Pentecost.

The “How” of the Utterance Manifestations – “speak” – *laleo* – to make sounds.

Acts 2:4 – they began to speak with other languages that God gave to them.

I Corinthians 14: 2-5 – Interpretation and Prophecy.

The Profit of the Utterance Manifestations

Speaking in Tongues – prayer and worship in the spirit; builds you up in the spirit; proof of the new birth.

Interpretation of Tongues & Prophecy – I Corinthians 14 – 9 uses of “Church,” 7 uses of “edify.”
Edification via encouragement and comfort.

What is the difference? - I Corinthians 14:22 – the “sign” indicating the significance of the work.
Mark 16:17.

Every born-again one can operate all nine manifestations

I Corinthians 14:5 – “ye all;” vss. 13 & 27

Acts 8:5-8 – Philip

The Three Utterance Manifestations are Greater Works than what Jesus Christ Did:
John 14:12.

Session 3

The How of Receiving Revelation

Heb 1:1-2	God speaks in different ways and at different times.
Phil 2:13	Beyond a shadow of a doubt – God works in you
Psalms 32:8	God will instruct, teach and guide
Proverbs 3:5-6	Acknowledge Him – be constantly aware of God
Eph 1:17	Revelation in the acknowledging of Him
James 1:5	Ask Him – a part of it, but in many instances, God initiates.
Examples:	I Kings 3:5-15 – Solomon; Acts 9:10-17 – Ananias
I Sam 3:1-21	Samuel learned to recognize the voice of God
I Sam 9:15	“In his ear”
I Kings 19:12	“A still small voice”
II Kings 6:15-17	The Lord opened the eyes of the young man and he saw
Luke 9:28-36	A vision given to Jesus, Peter, James and John

Acts 10:10-17	A vision given to Peter
Acts 16:9	A vision given to Paul
Psalm 25:4-5	Wait for Him to show, teach and guide
Psalm 123:1-2	Lift up your eyes unto the Lord

Session 4

Records of Revelation

Gen 40-41	The baker and the butler; the years of plenty and of famine
I Kings 14:1-16	The LORD said unto Ahijah, Behold, the wife of Jeroboam cometh
II Kings 3:5-20	When the minstrel played, the hand of the LORD came upon him
II Kings 4:1-7	The vessels of oil and the widow of the prophet
II Kings 5:1-14	Go and wash in Jordan seven times
II Kings 20:1-11	Thus saith the LORD, Set thine house in order; for thou shalt die
Dan 2	Then was the secret revealed unto Daniel in a night vision (vs. 19)
Mat 12:22-30	And Jesus knew their thoughts, and said unto them
Luke 19:28-35	Ye shall find a colt tied, whereon yet never man sat: loose him
John 4:17-19	Five husbands; and he whom thou now hast is not thy husband

Session 5

Discerning of Spirits – Introduction & Examples

II Cor 1:3	The Father of mercies, and the God of all comfort;
II Cor 4:1-4	The god of this world hath blinded the minds of them which believe not
John 10:10	The thief cometh to steal, kill, and destroy
Prov 10:22	The blessing of the LORD, it maketh rich, and he addeth no sorrow with it.
Rom 13:14	But put ye on the Lord Jesus Christ, and make not provision for the flesh, to <i>fulfil</i> the lusts <i>thereof</i> .
II Cor 2:11	Lest Satan should get an advantage of us: for we are not ignorant of his devices.
Eph 4:21-24	Put off concerning the former conversation the old man, which is corrupt according to the deceitful lusts
James 3:14-16	This wisdom descendeth not from above, but <i>is</i> earthly, sensual, devilish
James 4:1-3	From whence come wars and fightings among you? come they not hence, even of your lusts that war in your members
Mat 8:16-17	Many that were possessed with devils: and he cast out the spirits
Mat 17:14-21	Jesus rebuked the devil; and he departed out of him [vs. 21 not in older Greek manuscripts]
Mark 5:1-20	There met him out of the tombs a man with an unclean spirit
Mark 7:24-30	The devil is gone out of thy daughter
Mark 9:17-29	I have brought unto thee my son, which hath a dumb spirit [vs. 20 - tare: shook violently] [vs. 29 - “and fasting” not in older Greek manuscripts]
Luke 11:14-23	If Satan also be divided, how shall his kingdom stand?
Acts 8:9-24	There was a certain man, called Simon, which beforetime in the same city used sorcery
Acts 13:6-12	They found a certain sorcerer, a false prophet, a Jew, whose name was Barjesus

Session 6

Victory over the Adversary

56 uses of “spirit,” *pneuma*, in the New Testament classified as evil, or devil, spirits.

1. Some spirits are devils.
2. They cause harm always, sometimes in a multitude of ways.
3. They possess, or control, one part of a person’s mind or body.
4. Can be specialized and, at times, have names.
5. A person can have multiple devil spirits.
6. Spirits can speak, using the vocal mechanism of the person they possess.
7. Can be the basis of the curious arts, soothsaying, sorcery and witchcraft.

Christ’s authority Over Evil Spirits

Mark 1:21-28, 32-34 The casting out of devil spirits is new with Jesus Christ.

I Samuel 16:23 Not the casting out of a spirit, as that is not the only way they leave.

Luke 4:33-37, 40-41

This Authority Delegated

Matthew 10:8 To the twelve

Luke 10:1-3, 17 To the seventy

Mark 16:17 To those born from above, i.e. us

In the Name of Jesus Christ

Eph 1:19-21 Far above

Phil 2:8-10 Given a name above every other, that at his name, every knee must bow

Discerning of Spirits

II Cor 5:7 Not analysis, but discerning whether there is a spirit involved. Includes good spirits.

Mat 12:43-45 If evil, whether you may cast them out

Acts 16:16-18 After many days hearing the Word, believing was built so she could keep them out and stay delivered.

Acts 19:13-16 They took upon themselves – not by revelation – brought disastrous results

Build the Word of God to Keep Them Out

Col 3:16, 17 We are sons of God. We can use the name of Jesus Christ.

James 4:17 Resist the devil and he will flee

I Peter 5:7-9 Be sober, vigilant, resist steadfastly

Col 1:12, 13 We have been delivered from the power of darkness

Rom 8:1,15-17,31-39 No condemnation; if God be for us, who can be against us?

I John 4:4 Greater is the Christ in you than the devil and his spirits

Eph 6:10-18 The whole armor of God equips us to win the fight

Session 7

Impartation Manifestations – Introduction

Faith (believing), Workings of Miracles and Gifts of Healings are the action, power and impartation manifestations of the holy spirit. These are the application (action) of the revelation manifestations producing the desired results.

Believing – Special renewed mind believing according to the revelation of Word of Knowledge, Word of Wisdom, and Discerning of Spirits

Workings of Miracle – Bringing the impossible to pass by the manifestation of believing according to what God has revealed to you

Gifts of Healings – Bringing to pass healing by the manifestation of believing according to what God has revealed to you

Mark 11:23-24 Whosoever shall say unto this mountain, Be thou removed

Mat 14:22-33 Jesus went unto them, walking on the sea

II Kings 4:27-37 Then he returned, and walked in the house to and fro

Acts 9:36-43 Peter put them all forth, and kneeled down, and prayed

Acts 14:8-11 Perceiving that he had faith to be healed

Acts 28:7-10 Paul entered in, and prayed, and laid his hands on him

Session 8

The Manifestation of Believing

I Cor 12:9,11 Believing that is a manifestation of holy spirit. It is supernatural, energized by the spirit

I Cor 13:2 Believing so as to remove mountains is the manifestation according to revelation received

Mark 11:12-14,20-24 The cursing of the fig tree by revelation, the miraculous withering away by the manifestation of believing. Jesus uses this to teach his disciples about the manifestation.

Mat 21:18-22	This time, the fig tree withers away “presently,” immediately. Again, Jesus teaches them about the manifestation of believing
Mat 17:14-20	Jesus operated the manifestation of believing to cast out the devil spirit. Verse 21 is not in the text. Compare Mark 9:14-29.
Luke 17:6	Believing as a grain of mustard seed to do the impossible
James 5:17	Elijah prayed and there was no rain for 3 years and six months. I Kings 17:1, 9-16, 18:41 – “according to my word ... according to the Word of the Lord.”
II Kings 6:24	a measure of fine flour for a shekel
Joshua 3:13-17	the crossing of the Jordan River
Acts 27:1-44	Paul’s shipwreck

Session 9

The Manifestation of Gifts of Healings

Some Types of Healings:

- Instantaneous
- Cause removed, followed by gradual recovery

First Aid – Go to God directly

Second Aid – Ask another believer to pray/minister to you

Third Aid – Get medical care

All healing is of God, since God made the human body to heal itself

Mark 2:1-12	That ye may know that the Son of man hath power to forgive sins
III John 2	I wish above all things that thou mayest prosper and be in health
I Peter 2:24	We, being dead to sins, should live unto righteousness: by whose stripes ye were healed
Num 21:5-9	Fiery serpents – looking at brass snake healed a multitude

I Kings 17:17-24	Sidonian woman's son – Elijah stayed with it
II Kings 5:1-14	Naaman – his expectation almost cost him his healing
Mat 8:5-13	Centurion's servant
Mat 9:27-30	Two blind men
Mat 12:22-28	Blind man with spirit, JC accused of having Beelzebub
Mark 3:1-5	Withered hand
Mark 5:22-23, 35-42	Jairus' daughter
Mark 8:22-25	Blind man, trees walking
Mark 10:46-52	Blind Bartimaeus
John 4:46-54	Nobleman's son at Capernaum
John 5:1-17	Pool of Bethesda
John 9	Man born blind
Acts 3:1-8	Lame man at temple gate
Acts 5:12, 15-21	Shadow of Peter
Acts 9:32-35, 40	Aeneas & Tabitha
Acts 20:9-12	Eutychus falling out of window

Session 10

God Works in You

- I Cor 12:1, 4, 7-22 All can operate all nine manifestations. To do so, we must:
1) overcome ignorance and 2) will to operate them. We each have "longsuits", or functions, in the Church as members in particular.
- Rom 12:4-8 "office" – function
"gifts" – *charismata*, gifts of grace
"differing" – excelling
This list is a sampling of longsuits, or excelling functions.
"prophecy" – represents the manifestations
"teaching" – represents the 5 ministries of Ephesians 4:11
Get busy doing what God gives you to do within the Body.
- Eph 4:8-16 For the full-equipping of the saints, so that the saints can do the work of the ministry, with the result being the building-up of the body of Christ.
- Every saint has a God-given function, a unique service to provide within the Church.*
- I Thes 2:13 God's Word works effectually in you as you believe it.
- Phil 2:13,14 Do what God works in you
- Mark 16:20 A summary of the Book of Acts. The 1st Century Church made tremendous progress as they worked together with God, sharing His Word with every creature in all the world.
- Psalm 119:126 It is time for God to work
