Trust God

Ruth 2:11-12	The Lord, under whose wings thou art come to trust
2Sam 22:1-7,18-20	The God of my rock, in him will I trust
2Kings 18:1-8	Hezekiah trusted in the Lord God of Israel
2Kng 18:19-30	Rabshakeh tried to turn them from trusting God
Ps. 5:1-12	Let all those that put their trust in thee rejoice
Ps. 9:9-10	Thou hast not forsaken them that seek thee
Ps. 18:2	The Lord is my rock, in whom I will trust

Still Trust God

Ps. 28:6-7	My heart trusted in the Lord, and I am helped
Ps. 32:10	Mercy shall compass him about
Ps. 34:8	O taste and see that the Lord is good
Ps. 34:22	None of them that trust in him shall be desolate
Ps. 36:7,8	How excellent is thy lovingkindness
Ps. 37:3-5, 35-40	So thou shalt dwell in the land and be fed
Ps. 44:4-8	I will not trust in my bow - in God we boast
Ps. 56:11	In God have I put my trust: I will not be afraid of what man can do unto me
Ps. 62:5-10	God is a refuge for us, a rock
Ps. 112:1-8	His heart is fixed, trusting in God
Ps. 115	Trust God, rather than idols which talk not
Ps. 118:5-9	It is better to trust in the Lord than to put confidence in man

Keep Trusting God

Pro. 3:5,6	Trust in the Lord with all thine heart
Pro. 11:28	He that trusteth in his riches shall fall
Pro. 16:20	Whoso trusteth in the Lord, happy is he
Pro. 22:17-21	That thy trust may be in the Lord, I have made known to thee
Pro. 28:25,26	He that putteth his trust in the Lord shall be made fat. He that trusteth in his own heart is a fool
Pro. 29:25	Fear of man - snare; trust in the Lord - safe
Pro. 30:5	He is a shield to them that trust him
Isa. 12:2-3	I will trust and not be afraid
Isa. 26:3,4	Perfect peace, trusting God
Jer. 17:5-8	Blessed is the man that trusteth in the Lord
Dan. 3:28	God delivered his servants that trusted in him
2Cor. 1:8-10	We should trust in God which raiseth the dead
Phil. 3:4-8	If any other man thinketh he might trust in the flesh, I more

Reliance

II Chron 13	The children of Judah prevailed, because they relied [Heb. <i>Sha-an</i> : to rest, rely, lean upon, support oneself] upon the LORD God (vs. 18)
II Chron 16	Thou hast relied on the king of Syria, and not relied [Heb. <i>Sha-an</i>] on the LORD thy God (vs. 7)
Ps. 34:22	None of them that trust [Heb. <i>Chasa</i> : seek refuge, flee for protection, put trust in, confide or hope in] in him shall be desolate
Ps. 118:5-9	It is better to trust [Heb. <i>Chasa</i>] in the Lord than to put confidence in man (vs. 8)
Prov 3:5	Lean [Heb. <i>Sha-an</i>] not unto thine own understanding
Dan. 3:28	God delivered his servants that trusted [Aram. <i>rechats</i> : set one's trust on] in him

Rom. 12:10-14 Patient in mental pressure, continuing instant [steadfastly, faithful, persevering, be constant] in prayer (vs. 12)

II Cor. 1:8-10 We should trust in God which raiseth the dead

Faithful Reliability

Deut. 7:7-9 The LORD God is the faithful God

I Kings 17:1-16 The ravens, then the barrel of meal fed Elijah.

Ps. 36:5-9 Thy faithfulness reacheth unto the clouds

Ps. 92:1-5 To show forth thy faithfulness every night

Psalm 108:1-6 Your mercy (steadfast love, lovingkindness) is great above (higher than) the heavens and thy truth (faithfulness) reaches to the clouds (skies) (vs. 4)

Ps. 119:86 All thy commandments are faithful

Ps. 119:90 Thy faithfulness is unto all generations

Ps. 119:138 Thy testimonies are very faithful

Lam. 3:22-23 Great is thy faithfulness

Rom 8:35-39 Nothing can separate us from the love of God

Rom. 12:10-14 Patient in mental pressure, continuing instant [steadfastly, faithful, persevering, be constant] in prayer (vs. 12)

I Cor. 10:13 God is faithful, who will not suffer you to be tempted above what ye are able

II Thes. 3:3 The Lord is faithful, who will stablish you and keep you from evil

II Tim 4:16-182 The Lord stood with me, and strengthened me

Titus 1:9 Holding fast the faithful word

God is Good

Deut 1:25 It is a good land which the Lord our God doth give us

Deut 6:20-25 The Lord commanded us to do all these statutes...for our good

Deut 10:12-13 To keep the commandments of the Lord...for thy good

Deut 26:1-11 Rejoice in every good thing the Lord thy God hath given thee (vs. 11)

Josh 21:45 There failed not ought of any good thing

I Kings 8:54-56 There failed not one word of all his good promise

Ezra 3:10-11 Giving thanks unto the Lord; because he is good

Ezra 7:9 The good hand of his God upon him

Neh 2:18 The hand of my God which was good upon me

Psa 4:6-8 There be many that say, Who shall shew us any good?

Psa 25:8 Good and upright is the Lord

Psa 34:8-10 O taste and see that the Lord is good; they that seek the Lord shall not lack any good thing --

Psa 69:16 Hear me O Lord, for thy lovingkindness [*chesed* - steadfast love, lovingkindness] is good

Psa 73:1 Truly God is good to Israel, to such as are of a clean heart

Psa 84:11 No good will he withhold from them that walk uprightly

Psa 107:8-9 Oh that men would praise the Lord for His goodness

Psa 109:21 Thy mercy is good

Psa 143:10 Thy spirit is good

Mat 19:16-17 Why callest thou me good? There is none good but one, God

Acts 10:38 God anointed Jesus Christ, who went about doing good

Rom 2:4 The goodness of God leadeth men to repentance

Rom 8:28 All things work together for good to them that love God

I John 1:5 God is light, and in him there is no darkness at all

The Importance of Loving God

Deut. 6:4-5	Love the Lord thy God
Deut. 7:7-9	Them that love him
Deut. 10:12-16	Love him and serve
Deut. 11:1-25	Love the Lord
Deut. 30:15-20	Life and good
Joshua 22:1-5	Be diligent to love the Lord your God
I Chron. 10:1-14	How did Saul die?
Mat. 22:34-40	First and great commandment: love God
Rom. 8:28	All things work together for good
I John 5:2-3	For this is the love of God

Pray with Believing

I John 5:13-15	If we ask anything according to his will, he heareth us
Mat. 21:19-22	Whatsoever ye shall ask in prayer, believing, ye shall receive
Mark 11:13-24	When ye pray, believe that ye receive them, and ye shall have them
II Cor. 9:8	God is able to provide sufficiency in all things
Phil. 4:19	My God shall supply all your need
III John 3	God's will is health and prosperity
Rom 8:37-39	In all these things we are more than conquerors
II Cor 2:14	God always causes us to triumph in Christ
II Kings 4:1-7	God provided through the vessels of oil.

Radiant Living

Look to yourself -> miserable

- Psalm 77 I have considered the days of old; commune with mine own heart (vss 5-6)
- Prov 18:2 A fool hath no delight in understanding, but that his heart discover itself

Look to others -> distracted

- Psalm 73 I was envious at the foolish, when I saw the prosperity of the wicked
(verse 3)
- II Cor 10:12 They measuring themselves by themselves are not wise

Look to God -> peacefully radiant

- Psalm 34 They looked unto him, and were radiant (vs 4 – ASV et al)
- Isa 26:3 Perfect peace whose mind is stayed on thee
- Heb 12:2,3 Looking unto Jesus...consider him who endured
- Heb 3:1 Consider the apostle and high priest...Christ Jesus
- II Cor 4:18 We look not at the things which are seen, but not seen
- Col 3:1-2 Set your affection (mind/thoughts) on things above

Let Peace Rule

- Ps. 37:7-11 The meek shall delight themselves in the abundance of peace
- Ps. 37:34-40 The end of the perfect man is peace (vs. 34 - wait: expect)
- Ps. 119:165 Great peace have they which love thy law
- Prov. 3:1-6 God's commandments add peace (vs. 2)
- Prov. 3:13-18 All the paths of wisdom are peace
- Isa. 26:3-4 Perfect peace whose mind is stayed (steadfast, steady)
- Isa. 32:17 The work (achievement) of righteousness shall be peace

Isa. 48:18	Peace like a river
John 14:25-27	Not as the world gives
Ro. 5:1	Being justified by believing, we <u>have</u> peace with God, so how do we get that peace in our hearts?
Rom. 15:13	Joy & peace in believing
Ro. 8:6	Think spiritually, not thoughts of the senses
Phil. 4:6, 7	Peace shall guard your heart
Col. 3:15-16	Let the peace of God rule [be an umpire, decide, determine, direct, control] in your hearts

Raise Your Vision

II Kings 6:8-23	Chariots of fire – Raise your vision for your life
Ps. 60:11-12	Through God we shall do valiantly: for he shall tread down our enemies
Psalms 91	1000, 10,000 shall fall, but it shall not come nigh thee (vs. 7)
Prov 16:3	Commit(roll) your works unto the Lord, and your thoughts shall be established
Prov. 28:1 lion	The wicked flee when no man pursueth, but the righteous are bold as a lion
Prov 29:18	Where there is no vision (divine communication), the people perish (wander): but he that keepeth the law, happy is he
Eccl. 9:4	For to him that is joined to all the living there is hope [986 – <i>bittachown</i> – trust, confidence, hope]
Jer 17:7	Blessed is the man that trusteth in the LORD, and whose hope [4009 – <i>mibtach</i> – trust, confidence, refuge]the LORD is
Dan 6:1-23	Daniel prayed, survived the lion's den
Dan. 11:32	The people that do know their God shall be strong (stand firm) and do <i>exploits</i> (take action)
II Cor. 4:(1-18)	Look not at those things which are seen
Phil 3:3	Worship God in the spirit, rejoice in CJ, have no confidence in the flesh

Col 3:1-3 Seek those things which are above, where Christ sitteth (vs. 1)

II Tim 4:16-18 At my first answer [defense] no man stood with me.
The Lord stood with me...shall deliver me from every evil work.

Summary: Rejoice in God's Goodness

Ex 18:1-12 Jethro rejoiced for all the goodness which the Lord had done to Israel
(vs 9)

Ps 146 Happy is he that hath the God of Jacob for his help (vs. 5)

Prov 16:20 Whoso trusteth in the Lord, happy is he

Deut 16:13-17 The Lord thy God shall bless thee in all thine increase...therefore thou
shalt surely rejoice (vs. 15)

Deut 26:1-11 Thou shalt rejoice in every good thing which the Lord thy God hath given
unto thee (vs. 11)

I Chron 16:7-36 Let the heart of them rejoice that seek the Lord (vs. 10)

II Chron 20:27 The Lord had made them to rejoice over their enemies

Psalms 5:11-12 Let those that trust thee rejoice, let them ever shout for joy

Psalms 16:11 In thy presence is fulness of joy

Psalms 43:4 God my exceeding joy (NLT: the source of all my joy; NIV: my joy and
my delight; lit: gladness of my joy)

Prov 15:13-15 A merry heart maketh a cheerful countenance (vs. 13)
He that is of a merry heart hath a continual feast (vs. 15)

Rom 5:1-8 Rejoice in hope of the glory of God (vs. 2)

Rom 12:9-21 Rejoicing in hope (vs. 12)

Phil 3:3 Rejoice in Christ Jesus, and have no confidence in the flesh

Phil 4:4-9 Rejoice in the Lord always, and again I say, Rejoice (vs. 4)

I Tim. 6:17 Trust in the living God, who giveth us richly all things to enjoy

Never give up on God – He has certainly not given up on you!
