Deut. 7:8	God's motives
Deut. 23:5	God turned the curse (of Balaam) into a blessing, because He loved
Ps. 13:5-6	I have trusted in thy steadfast love
Ps. 34:8-10	O taste and see that the Lord is good; they that seek the Lord shall not lack any good thing --
Ps. 36:7-9	How excellent (precious) is thy lovingkindness
Ps. 92:1-2	To shew forth (declare) thy lovingkindness in the morning
Ps. 119:165	Great peace have they which love thy law, and nothing shall offend
Jer. 9:23, 24	He knoweth the Lord which exercises lovingkindness (vs 24)

### Grace and Judgement

II Kings 5:18-19        Go in peace  
John 8:10-11            Neither do I condemn thee  
Mat 12:1-8                David and the shewbread (sacred loaves)  
Romans 7                I delight in the law of God after the inward man (vs. 22)  
II Cor 3                  Where the spirit of the Lord is, there is liberty (vs. 17)  
Mat 7:1-5                Judge not, that ye be not judged (vs. 1)  
Rom 2:1                  Thou that judgest doeth the same things  
II Cor 10:1-12         They measuring themselves by themselves are not wise (vs. 12)  
Rom 5:1ff                We HAVE peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ

### Grace and Vision

II Kings 6:8-23        Chariots of fire – Raise your vision for your life  
Ps. 60:11-12            Through God we shall do valiantly: for he shall tread down our enemies  
Ps. 71:1-15              Thou art my hope (vs. 5), I will hope continually (vs. 14)  
Ps. 91                    1000, 10,000 shall fall, but it shall not come nigh thee (vs. 7)

Ps. 146:5	Happy is he that hath the God of Jacob for his help, whose hope is in the LORD his God
Ps. 147:11	The LORD taketh pleasure in them that fear him, in those that hope in his mercy
Prov 16:3	Commit(roll) your works unto the Lord, and your thoughts shall be established
Prov. 28:1	The wicked flee when no man pursueth, but the righteous are bold as a lion
Prov 29:18	Where there is no vision (divine communication), the people perish (wander): but he that keepeth the law, happy is he
Eccl. 9:4	For to him that is joined to all the living there is hope
Jer 17:7	Blessed is the man that trusteth in the LORD, and whose hope the LORD is
Jer. 29:11-13	An expected end [NRS - a future with hope – <i>tiqvah</i> – hope, expectation, grounds for hope] (vs. 11)
Dan. 11:32	The people that do know their God shall be strong (stand firm) and do <i>exploits</i> (take action)
Rom. 8:31-39	Nothing shall separate us from the love of God!
II Cor. 4:(1-)18	Look not at those things which are seen
Phil 3:3	Worship God in the spirit, rejoice in CJ, have no confidence in the flesh
Col 3:1-3	Seek those things which are above, where Christ sitteth (vs. 1)

### Grace and Our Savior

Prov 17:22	A merry heart doeth good like a medicine
Luke 2:8-11	Good tidings of great joy - a Savior is born
John 3:16	God so loved the world that he gave his only begotten son, Our Savior
John 10	Our Savior came to give a life which is more than abundant
Acts 8:5-8	Christ preached, great joy

Ro. 12:12	Rejoicing in hope, persevering in prayer
Ro. 15:13	Joy & peace in believing
Gal. 5:22	Fruit of totality of new nature
Phil. 3:1-3	Rejoice in Lord, no confidence in flesh
Col. 1:9-11	Patience with joyfulness
Heb 2:8-18	Our Savior came to deliver God's people
Heb 4:14-16	Our Savior can be touched by the feeling of our infirmities, come <b>BOLDLY</b> to the throne of his GRACE
I John 1:3-4	Fulness of joy – fellowship

### Grace and Living Life

Deut. 32:44-47	<i>It is</i> not a vain thing for you; because it <i>is</i> your life
Ps 27:1-4	The LORD is the strength of my life; of whom shall I be afraid?
John 5:24	He that believes His Word has life
John 10:10	A life which is more than abundant is available <b>THROUGH THE LORD JESUS CHRIST</b> , in spite of what the thief may attempt to do
Acts 13:46	God's Word brings eternal life
Rom 5:1-18	By the righteousness of one, justification of life (vs. 18)
Rom. 8:1-3	For the law of the spirit of life made us free
Phil. 2:16	The Word of Life
I Thes. 4:9-12	You are taught of God to love one another (vs. 11 - aspire to lead a quiet life, aspire to live quietly, let it be a point of honor with you to keep calm)
I Tim. 2:1-4	Quiet and peaceable life in all godliness
I Peter 5:6-9	Casting all your care (mental distraction) upon him, for he careth for you
I John 1:1-4	The Word of Life

I John 4:4                      Greater is he that is in you than he that is in the world

### Grace and Believing

Mark 9:14-27                If you can believe.

Children:

Matt. 15:22-28              Canaanite woman believed for daughter.

Demented persons:

Luke 4:33-36                Man with unclean spirit in synagogue.

Dead people:

Acts 9:36-42                Peter prayed, Dorcas raised.

Two types of believing:

Mat. 9:22                      Woman with issue of blood healed.

Job 3:25                        Fear brought disaster. Later, believing restored all.

Synchronized life:

Mark 11:23-24                Do not doubt in heart.

Mat. 12:34                      Out of the abundance of the heart.

Romans 8:35-39              Persuaded - confession (practical key).

Heb. 4:2                        Mixed with believing.

II Cor. 10:3-5                Every thought to the obedience of Christ - Synchronized with God's Word.

What we confess with our mouths will eventually make it into our hearts. What we believe in our hearts determines what we receive in our daily living. We need to synchronize our words, our actions, and our thoughts with God's Word in order to walk in the deliverance to which God has called us.
