# Introduction

There are at least four approaches for how to address the Bible:

- 1. Read parts of the Bible, decide it is difficult, distasteful, and appears to contradict itself so quit reading it
- 2. Choose the Bible verses you like and ignore the rest
- 3. Focus on the verses your church leaders like, and ignore the ones they ignore
- 4. Let the Bible interpret itself so you don't have to guess or follow the guesses of others

# The Bible Interprets Itself

II Timothy 2:15 - rightly divide: straight cutting, not crooked.

Psalms 14:1 - No God?

I Corinthians 12:1 - not ignorant

II Peter 1:20 - No Private Interpretation (idios - one's own)

interpretation - letting your mind loose

It must interpret itself

# To Whom The Word Is Written (or to whom it applies)

I Corinthians 10:32 - Jew, Gentile, Church of God

Romans 15:4 - For our learning

I Corinthians 10:11 - Admonition - examples [cf. vs. 1, 2]

Romans 15:8 - JC: circumcision; gospels: Jews (& Gentiles)

#### To us:

I Corinthians 1:2 - church of God

Ephesians 1:1 - Saints, faithful

#### Zealous for law:

James 1:1 - 12 tribes (OT minded)

Acts 21:20 - zealous for law

Galatians 5:1 - Stand fast in liberty

# Example: Grace and Law

Deut 6:25	Law
Rom 3:20-26	Grace
Rom 4:4-5	Believing is counted for righteousness
Rom 5:1-9	This grace wherein we stand
Rom 6:14	We are under grace
Rom 11:5-6	If by grace, then no more of works
Rom 16:24	The grace of our Lord Jesus Christ be with you all
I Cor 1:3, 4	Grace unto you, I thank God for the grace
I Cor 15:10	By the grace of God I am what I am
II Cor. 9:6-8	God is able to make all grace abound toward you, that ye, having all sufficiency in all things, may abound to every good work

Sufficiency: vs. 8 – autarkeia: A perfect condition of life in which no aid or support is needed; Sufficiency of the necessities of life; A mind contented with its lot

II Cor 12:7-10	My grace is sufficient for thee (vs. 9)
Gal 1:3, 6	Grace to you, called into the grace of Christ
Gal 2:21	I do not frustrate the grace of God
Eph 1:2, 7	Grace to you, the riches of his grace
Eph 2:5, 7-8	By grace are ye saved
Eph 3:1-13	Administration of the grace of God (vs. 2)
Titus 3:7	Justified by his grace, heirs according to the hope of eternal life.
Heb. 4:16	Let us come <b>boldly</b> unto the throne of <b>grace</b>
I Peter 1:13	Wherefore gird up the loins of your mind and be strong: Therefore, prepare your minds for action; be self-controlled; set your hope fully on the grace to be given you when Jesus Christ is revealed. (NIV)

# Salvation, Eternal Life, and Inheritance

Eph 2	By grace are ye saved – the gift of God (vs. 8)
Rom 11:1-6	If works, then no more grace (vs. 6)
I Cor 3:10-15	We receive rewards for good works, but are saved regardless
I Pet 1:23	Being born again of incorruptible seed
I Cor 15:51-58	We shall all be changed (vs. 51)
Eph 1:7-14	We have obtained an inheritance, holy spirit is the downpayment
Col 1:12-14	God has made us adequate to be partakers of the inheritance
Col 3:4	When Christshall appear, then shall ye also appear with him in glory
Col 3:23-25	Rewards do depend on works, but our inheritance is by grace
I Thes 4:13-18	We will meet the Lord in the air – so shall we ever be
I Pet 1:3-4	An <b>inheritance</b> incorruptible and undefiled, and that fadeth not away

# Some Difficult Verses

I Cor 6:9-11	The unrighteous shall not inherit the kingdom of God [NOTE: we are righteous!]
I Cor 15:50	Flesh and blood cannot inherit the kingdom of God [NOT: keep reading, we shall all be changed!]
Gal 5:16-25	They which do such things shall not inherit the kingdom of God [NOTE: <b>not</b> us, as we already have the inheritance]
Eph 5:1-6	No whoremonger has any inheritance in the kingdom of God [NOTE: this refers to idolaters – those not yet born again]
Heb 6:4-6	If they fall away, impossible to renew them to repentance [NOTE: once you are born again, it is incorruptible seed – no need to renew]
Rev 2:10-11	He that overcometh shall not be hurt of the second death [NOTE: we will

have bodies immortal and incorruptible, so this **cannot** apply to us]

Rev 3:21 To him that overcometh will I grant to sit with me [NOTE: we are already

seated in the heavenly places with Christ, so why would we have to earn

that privilege by overcoming anything? (Eph 2:5)]

Rev 21:7-8 Second death

Rev 20:11-15 Judgement and lake of fire

# Food, the Law, and Grace

Lev 11	Dietary Laws – prohibition about eating many things
Mat 15:1-20	Not that which goeth into the mouth defileth a man, but that which goeth out of his mouth
Acts 10:9-15	What God hath cleansed, that call not thou common [cf. Acts 10:28; 11:9]
Acts 15:1-20	Abstain from meats offered to idols (vs. 29) [Acts 21:20 – zealous for the law]
I Cor 8	Meat commendeth us not to God (vs. 8) [we can't win God's approval by what we eat $-$ NIV] NOTE which brother is "weak"
I Sam 21:1-6	David and the shewbread [consecrated bread]

Mat 12:1-8 Jesus Christ and the shewbread

# Sin and Grace

Rom 5-6 Where sin abounded, grace did much more abound (5:20)

Rom 7 I delight in the law of God after the inward man (vs. 22)

Rom 8:1-4 No condemnation

I Cor 11 Long hair in the church [NOTE: no such custom]

I John 5:1-5 His commandments are not grievous (vs. 3)

Mat 22:34-40 On these two commandments hang all the law and the prophets

Gal 5:14	All the law is fulfilledlove thy neighbor as thyself
I Thes 5:16-18	Rejoice, pray, give thanks
II Cor 3:1-17	Where the spirit of the Lord is, there is liberty (vs. 17)
Mat 6:1-5	They have their reward (vs. 2)
II Cor 10:12	They comparing themselves by themselves are not wise
II Tim 2:1	Be strong in the grace

Summary – Rejoice	
Luke 2:8-10	Even at his birth, great rejoicing
Acts 8:5-8	Christ preached, great joy
Ro. 5:1-2	Rejoice in hope of the glory of God (Rev. 21:23)
Ro. 12:12	Rejoicing in hope, persevering in prayer
Ro. 15:13	Joy & peace in believing
II Cor 1:24	Helpers of your joy
Gal. 5:22	Fruit of totality of new nature
Phil. 3:1-3	Rejoice in Lord, no confidence in flesh
Phil. 4:4	Rejoice in the lord alway
Col. 1:9-11	Patience with joyfulness
I Thes. 5:16-18	Rejoice evermore
I John 1:3-4	Fulness of joy - fellowship
