Sufficiency: vs. 8 - autarkeia: A perfect condition of life in which no aid or support is needed; Sufficiency of the necessities of life; A mind contented with its lot

Gal 1:3, 6	Grace to you, called into the grace of Christ
Gal 2:21	I do not frustrate the grace of God
Eph 1:2, 7	Grace to you, the riches of his grace

Eph 3:1-13	Administration of the grace of God (vs. 2)
Titus 3:7	Justified by his grace, heirs according to the hope of eternal life.
Heb. 4:16	Let us come boldly unto the throne of grace

Lev 11	Dietary Laws – prohibition about eating many things
Mat 15:1-20	Not that which goeth into the mouth defileth a man, but that which goeth out of his mouth
Acts 10:9-15	What God hath cleansed, that call not thou common [cf. Acts 10:28; 11:9]
Acts 15:1-20	Abstain from meats offered to idols (vs. 29) [Acts 21:20 – zealous for the law]
I Cor 8	Meat commendeth us not to God (vs. 8) [we can't win God's approval by what we eat – NIV] NOTE which brother is "weak"
I Sam 21:1-6	David and the shewbread [consecrated bread]
Mat 12:1-8	Jesus Christ and the shewbread

John 7:5	Even his brothers did not believe in him (NLT) – would include James
John 16:9	The world's sin is that it refuses to believe in me (NLT)
Rom 13:8-10	Love worketh no ill – the fulfilling of the law
Gal 2:17-18	But suppose we seek to be made right with God through faith in Christ and then we are found guilty because we have abandoned the law. Would that mean that Christ has led us into sin? Absolutely not! Rather, I am a sinner if I rebuild the old system of law I already tore down. (NLT)

Gal 5:14	All the law is fulfilled in one word – love your neighbor as yourself
Gal 6:2	Bear ye one another's burdens, and so fulfil the law of Christ
Heb 2:9	What we do is see Jesus, who for a little while was given a position "a little lower than the angels": and because he suffered death for us, he is now "crowned with glory and honor." Yes, by God's grace, Jesus tasted death for everyone." (NLT)

Why it Matters

I Sam 16:1-14	The LORD looketh on the heart
Isa 1:1-17	Bring no more vain oblations (meaningless offerings). Cf. Mat 23:23
II Kings 5:1-19	In this thing pardon thy servant
Mat 1:5	Salmon married a Canannite, and Boaz married a Moabite. Cf. Num 33:55, Deut 23:3
Esther 2	Esther was part of the harem, but certainly walked with God and saved the Israelites from complete destruction
Joshua 2	Rahab lied unto the guards, but saved many lives
II Kings 6:8-20	Elisha lied and saved Israel from the Syrians
II Cor 3:17	Where the spirit of the Lord is, there is liberty

Let Grace Abound

Rom 5-6	Where sin abounded, grace did much more abound (5:20)
Rom 7	I delight in the law of God after the inward man (vs. 22)
I John 5:1-5	His commandments are not grievous (vs. 3)
II Cor 3	Where the spirit of the Lord is, there is liberty (vs. 17)
